Who

can receive it?



Recipients of social assistance with children living at home receive DKK 500 per child per month. The supplement is granted for up to three children.



A single parent receives DKK 125 per child per month. The supplement is granted for a maximum of three children.

What

can you use it for?



Leisure activities:
e.g. sports activities and equipment.



Cultural Activities:
e.g. cinema, theatre and museums.



Social and educational activities:
e.g. school camps or other activities related to school, daycare, and leisure programmes.



Educational equipment:
e.g. school bags, computers, pencils, etc.

How do you

receive the payment?



The leisure supplement is paid automatically after you have received social assistance for three months. Every quarter, documentation must be submitted for at least one third of the expenses covered by the leisure supplement.



Upload the receipts on the municipality's website or submit them physically to the municipality.



If the documentation requirement is not met, payments will be suspended until sufficient documentation has been uploaded again.

Tips on the leisure supplement:

1

Upload or submit your receipts to the municipality as soon as possible, so you can keep track of them.

If you have documentation for an amount higher than what you have received in leisure supplement, it may be beneficial to upload all of it, as it can be used as documentation for multiple periods.

If you are in doubt, always ask your municipal case-worker.
