HOW TO GET HELP

- We will send you a message with more information
- We will find a volunteer who wants to practice Danish with you. Together you and the volunteer language trainer find a platform that works for both of you, for example, Facetime, Whatsapp, Teams, or Messenger.

After that, you will become permanently matched with a volunteer language trainer who, through an agreed period, will help you with the Danish language. You will be introduced online to each other via the Danish Refugee Council's consultant, but you yourself decide when and how often you meet. Normally, you talk together for 30 minutes - 1 hour a week.

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
